Title: How to Use a Cotterless Crank Puller Tool

The cotterless crank puller tool is used to remove the crank arm from the bottom bracket shaft of certain bike models.

- 1. Unthread and remove the crank arm bolt cover.
- 2. Remove the crank arm bolt.
- Thread the crank puller tool into the crank arm in place of the crank arm bolt cover.
- 4. Thread the tool into the crank arm as far as the crank arm will allow. It may be necessary to use a wrench to tighten further. Damage to the crank arm threads and the tool can occur if not threaded properly.
- 5. Turn the handle on the tool. Some crank puller tools do not have a handle. A crescent wrench or open face wrench should be used as the handle in these instances. As you continue to turn the handle of the tool, this pulls the crank arm off the bottom bracket shaft.
